What. The Chilko Experience is a seven home estate built on a 5M acre wilderness tract in southern British Columbia. <http://chilkoexperience.com/>. It is arguably the nicest wilderness rec facility in North America. It recently opened to the public. It's an all-inclusive luxury adventure multisport destination. Clients tend to be couples, families and multi-generational families. In 2016 it will become a member of Nat Geo's Unique Lodges of the World Program. Nat Geo now has eleven lodges in north America and forty five lodges world wide.

Where. The Chilko Experience is located 150 air mile due north of Vancouver in the Chilcotin region of BC.

Travel Options. Three exist: Direct charters from Vancouver take one hour and cost \$700 pp round trip. There are six flights per day, except Saturday, into the region's commerce center, Williams Lake. Cost is \$300 pp round trip. A vehicle can be rented there for the three hour drive to Chilko. Last option is to drive from Vancouver. Transit time is 10 hours.
